April 20, 2018



5. Commission reviewed and signed erroneous assessments.





4. Commissioner reviewed budget numbers.







4. Commission met with Chief Deputy Joe Colston regarding Deputy Sheriff's Supplemental Salary Fund.



The Commission met pursuant to adjournment with Mike Minor, Presiding Commissioner and Associate Commissioners Mike Whelan and Ron Staggs present and among other proceedings the following orders were had to wit:

1. Commission approved previous minutes.
2. Commission held public hearing on re-zoning for a RV park for Bergman and Woodford for Township 54, Range 8W, Section 21. The submitted application for approval would change the zoning from A-1 to C-1. Those in attendance were as follows: Mike Minor- Presiding Commissioner, Mike Whelan- Eastern Commissioner, Ron Staggs- Western Commissioner, Christina Buie- Interim Planning & Zoning Secretary, Dave Bergman, and Mary Gillitzer. No opposition was made. Commissioner Staggs made a motion to accept application as requested. Commissioner Whelan seconded. All in favor by voting: Staggs – yes, Whelan – yes, Minor – yes.
3. Commission held public hearing on re-zoning for a RV park for Michael Bedwell for Township 55, Range 8W, Section 11. The submitted application for approval would change the zoning from A-1 to C-1. Those in attendance were as follows: Mike Minor- Presiding Commissioner, Mike Whelan- Eastern Commissioner, Ron Staggs- Western Commissioner, Christina Buie- Interim Planning & Zoning Secretary, Allen Mehrer- Army Corp of Engineers, Heather Utterback, Vincent Breyfogle, Rick & Sherie Poertner, Patricia & Lloyd Reed, Rich Matheny, Charles & Debbie Caselman, Diane Breiding, Michael Bedwell, and George Poertner. Opposition to this application was made by the above concerned citizens. Concerns included a lack of engineer design plan, lagoon and/or sewage system plans, drainage overage, privacy fence, possible abundance of ATV's, road maintenance, and increased trash. Concerns were heard and addressed. Commissioner Staggs made a motion to approve the application with stipulations attached to address the concerns of the citizens. Stipulations are as follows: Mr. Bedwell will need to provide engineer design plans, privacy fence on the north and east side of the property, ATV restrictions, buried electrical lines, weekly trash pickup, and the entrance and exit roads must be off of a blacktop highway. Once these accommodations have been completed, this application will be approved. Commissioner Whelan seconded the motion. All in favor by voting: Staggs – yes, Whelan – yes, Minor – yes.
4. Robert M. Wilkerson appeared before the commission regarding a planning and zoning question.





6. Commission discussed road issues with road and bridge supervisor, Allan DeOrnellas.






